Items to be brought for service

The temple fee is only for the priest's service. Devotees are responsible for bringing the items for the Pooja. Temple can also provide SAMAGRI at a nominal charge if a prior request is made.

Transportation

They are expected to pick up the priest at least 30 minutes or more, depending on the distance where they live. We expect the devotees to be punctual and strictly follow the schedule timings, and of course, we understand emergencies.

Option 2: If you are unable to pick up & drop off our priest for any reason, we would drive to your location. In such cases, a donation should be made to the temple or based on mileage.
